If a speaker is in the middle of a sentence when time is called, he/she may finish their thoughts before sitting down. The time guidelines ensure that others will have an opportunity to speak. In accordance with Civil Code Section 4935 the Board may adjourn to, or meet solely in, executive session to consider litigation, matters relating to the formation of contracts with third parties, member discipline, personnel matters, or to meet with a member, upon the member's request, regarding the member's payment of assessments, as specified in Section 5665. Further, the Board shall adjourn to, or meet solely in, executive session to decide whether to foreclose on a lien pursuant to Civil Code Section 5705(b). Any matter discussed in executive session shall be generally noted in the minutes of the immediately following Board meeting that is open to the entire membership.
