**Hours of Operation: Daily- 8:15am to 4:15pm Closed 12pm-1pm for Lunch**

## **Dumping Policy**

1. **ONLY 1 pick-up load or equivalent per week per property**
2. **No more than 1 foot above the sides of bed**
3. **Mix or Match of Household garbage and yard waste clean up**
4. **House hold garbage must be in tied off bags or covered containers**
5. **Additionally you are allowed 1 pick-up load per week of yard clean up debris**
6. **NO BUTANE CANS! Attempting to dump or dumping of butane cans will result in immediate notification of Authorities, immediate loss of privilege, and possible Littering fine of \$1,000.00.**
7. **Must have Visible TRANSFER STATION STICKER matching vehicle and property owner.**
8. **No Profanity, threats of violence, or illegal dumping. Violations will result in immediate loss of privilege, possible Littering fine of \$1,000.00, and notification of Authorities.**

**The following are EXTRA Charges:**

1. **Tires \$2.00 each**
2. **Tires with rims \$4.00 each**
3. **Refrigerators, deep freezers, couches, recliners, love seats, dishwashers, and window air conditioners \$10.00 each**

**You must have a receipt from the Association Office showing you have pre-paid to dump.**

## **Effective November 1, 2018**

These new charges reflect Green Waste increase of 11%.
