With the holidays starting to come to an end it's time to start thinking of the next big season, TAX SEASON. Tehama County Community Action Agency is ramping up to provide its annual VITA program. VITA is the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program that provides Federal and State income tax return preparation services to local families and individuals **100% FREE of charge**. IRS-certified preparers are trained to ensure that taxpayers receive all the tax credits they are eligible for such as the Earned Income Tax Credit, the Child Tax Credit and the various education credits. VITA is offered to all households with an Adjusted Gross Income (AIG) of \$53,000 and under for the 2015 tax year.

Community Action also provides customers with the opportunity for financial education. At the tax sites taxpayers will have access to information and options to make their tax refund work for them. 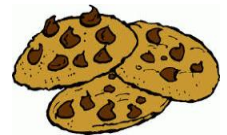

Sign Up For E-Statements

Did you know you could help eliminate the need for paper statements? You can sign up for electronic statements (e-statements) and have your statements e-mailed to you each month. Your statements may be viewed, printed or saved to your computer and are archived for easy reference. Simply go to www.estmt.net and put in your Registration ID, found on the upper right hand of your statement, to get started! Signing up for e-statements helps save paper, postage and time; saving the association money that can go to other projects. It also allows you the convenience to look up your statement from anywhere there is a computer and internet connection. You have the choice to switch back to paper statements at any time if you find e-statements are not for you.

Be a responsible pet owner, never let your dogs run loose

We have had several reports of dogs running loose and abandoned dogs. In some of these reports injuries have occurred to livestock and other pets. It is important that you know there are rules to being a dog owner and you are ultimately responsible for any damage your animal may cause. The law also states that "Every person who willfully abandons any animal is guilty of a misdemeanor". CA PENAL § 597s and per Tehama County: 7.25.050 - **Dogs running at large prohibited.** "No person shall permit a dog to run at large from private property owned by the owner of such dog, or from private property to which such owner has a right of possession." In addition dogs must be restrained by substantial leash and under physical control of its owner anytime you leave your property. This includes all areas of Rancho Tehama, the Beach Park, The Creek, Fawn Meadows, the Post Office, Office and Rec. Hall.

NO SHOOTING/ NO HUNTING ALLOWED

PISTOL POINT CLOSED



A policy by resolution 2000-2 was established in May 2000 implementing "no hunting or taking of game, other than fish" allowed in Rancho Tehama. Resolution 2000-1 was also adopted as "no shooting" except in a designated shooting range. Rancho Tehama **DOES NOT** have an active/ designated shooting range. The area known as Pistol Point has been closed for years, therefore there is no shooting anywhere within Rancho Tehama. The resolutions are not intended to preclude the use of legal firearms for self-defense.
