HUMBOLDT BRIDGE RIBBON CUTTING CERMONY

The new Humboldt Bridge and pedestrian path at the back of the Rancho Tehama Community is now completed, after years of planning with the involvement of numerous individuals and organizations. There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony on Friday, March 27th at 11 a.m. followed by a reception at the Rancho Tehama Recreation Hall. Individuals and organizations involved in the bridge construction will participate in the event. The public, especially Rancho Tehama residents are invited to attend. Many people worked to ensure that the bridge would be built. The Rancho Tehama Association Board of Directors provided oversight for all aspects of the construction. The United States Agricultural Department (USDA) provided the loan, a construction company built the bridge, and Tehama County Officials provided technical assistance to ensure that county codes were met.

With completion of the bridge, several school bus stops on the west side of the bridge will be identified and children will be able to board a school bus close to their homes. Trucks, buses, and fire vehicles will now be able to provide services to residents west of the bridge.

The bridge was declared unsafe several years ago, which led to difficult conditions for the residents living on the other side of the bridge. Large trucks could not go over the bridge to deliver products. The school districts would not allow school busses to cross the bridge, so children had to be brought to the west side of the bridge to be picked up. The Old Time Fire Fighters positioned a fire engine on the east side of the bridge for fire protection.

Calling all Rancho Tehama Owners And/Or Resident Artists For Logo Competition

The Rancho Tehama Association is looking for a new visual identity and needs your help. We are seeking Rancho Tehama homeowners and/or residents, regardless of age, who can design a creative and innovative logo design which will become the official Rancho Tehama Association logo. The logo should be recognizable and help promote a positive image of Rancho Tehama Reserve as a friendly community located in the foothills of the Sacramento Valley. Please read below for more details regarding logo design, contest rules & submission requirements.

How to Enter the Contest

The contest begins on February 1, 2015. Submissions will be accepted through March 27, 2015. The date on the email or the postmark must be no later than March 27th. A winner will be announced at the Rancho Tehama Association Board meeting in April. In order for your entry to be submitted and reviewed by our judges, all entries must be:

Submitted to Carrie Lee, Rancho Tehama Association Manager via email to: carrierta@rtr.net as a high resolution pdf with 300 dpi or higher. The date on the email must be no later than March 27th to be eligible for judging. Email must include the full name of the contestant who created the logo, a mailing address, an email address if available, and a telephone number.

Or

Be mailed to Carrie Lee, Rancho Tehama Association Manager at P.O. Box 5111, Corning Ca 96021 and be postmarked no later than March 27th. The submission must include a printed design of the logo with a high resolution pdf with 300 dpi or higher and a thumb drive or cd of the logo. The submission must also include the full name of the contestant who created the logo, a mailing address, an email address (if available), and a telephone number.

The Rancho Tehama Association assumes no responsibility for failure of the application to be received in the RTA office before the stated deadline.

Logo Requirements

^ Professional: This logo may be featured on the Rancho Tehama Association website, and other mediums (stationary, pamphlets, t-shirts etc). As a result, while the logo needs to be eye-catching, it must still be legible.

Theme: Logo must promote a positive image of the community of Rancho Tehama Association, a quiet private country community located in the heart of Tehama county. Design should be universal in theme

^ Name: The words "Rancho Tehama Association" must be part of the logo design.

^ Color: There are no limitations and any colors may be used. However, logo must look good in both color or in black and white.

^ Integrity: The logo must be an original work of art and cannot contain copyrighted material. The logo must have been created and edited by the contestant(s). The logo may not include images or licensed images that have been previously published. It must be easily reproducible and scalable for large and small formatting.

Contest Details

A winner will be selected from the submitted entries by the panel of judges appointed by the RTA Board of Directors. Contestants agree that the Rancho Tehama Association may publish the logo and name(s) and may use both for advertising campaigns and/or marketing materials in the future. Contestants assign all ownership rights, including all intellectual property rights of the logo, to the Rancho Tehama Association. The winning logo becomes the sole property of the Rancho Tehama Association. The Panel of Judges reserves the right to not select a winner if, in its sole discretion, no suitable entries are received.

Prize

The Contest winner will receive a cash award of \$200 (and bragging rights!).
