Quorum Amendment Election Extended

The Board sent ballots to members in good standing in hopes that members will vote to lower the quorum requirements set forth in our Bylaws. At the election meeting we received only 323 ballots out of 1487 members in good standing. We need to receive 1116 'yes' votes for the amendment to pass. If we receive 745 yes votes we can petition the court to lower the quorum requirements. As you can see, we are still far from where we need to be for the amendment to pass. Therefore, the election was extended to June 18th at 10am to allow more time to receive ballots.

The board is sending out ballots to those who have not yet voted. Please take a few moments to send in your ballot as soon as you receive it.

Board Of Director Election

The Board of Director Election ballots will soon go out to members in good standing. There are three seats up this year, Juan Caravez, Ruth Haskell and Malia Hard. Please be sure to keep a look-out for ballots and return your ballot ASAP. We are hoping to be able to reach quorum on our own without the additional expense of having to go to court. A list of candidates running will be available at the Association Office after June 1st.

The Tehama County Board of Supervisors voted to adopt an ordinance on April 26th to rezone Rancho Tehama removing the "MH" overlay. Starting May 26th all mobile homes moved onto any lot in Rancho Tehama must to be 10 years old or newer. Variances cannot be granted for mobile homes older than 10 years. This does not affect older homes that are already on the Ranch.

Renter Registration

Do you own a rental property in Rancho Tehama? Have you registered your renters with the association office? If you rent out your home you must submit a copy of the rental agreement or fill out the renter registration form from the association office. It is important that the association has this up to date information on file. There are many scenarios that can arise which would require the Association to be aware of who is living on the property, such as use of the Transfer Station. Please report all renters or change of renters as soon as possible.

- When you can, bring them in! They will appreciate the air conditioner as much as you do.

- Limit exercise and never walk them on the hot asphalt. If you wouldn't walk barefooted they shouldn't either.
- Visit the groomer. Many dogs benefit from a summer cut, ask the groomer about your breed.
- Brush your animal frequently to get rid of the loose fur
- Fill a kiddie pool or hosing down your animal will lower their body temperature and make the outside air feel cooler.
