Your current Board of Directors are Paula Skubic, Juan Caravez, Malia Hard and Michael Wright. The remaining board members plan to appoint a member to the open seat at the next open board meeting.

Changes to the Rancho Tehama Transfer Station/ Recycling

There was a mutual change in the agreement with Big Foot Recycling and the Board of Directors. The recycling center "for paid recyclables" will now be open on **SATURDAY'S ONLY!** Please plan according. This will allow the association to have total control over the transfer station and help save in the cost of running the transfer station. We will start with one day a week for recyclables and will reevaluate if we need to increase to two days a week. We feel that this will best suit the needs of our members. We can still provide a valuable service at a fraction of the cost!

As a reminder, you must have a sticker issued from the association office in order to use the Transfer Station. There is also a use restriction of one truck load per week. This will also help keep cost down and to give fair use of the transfer station to all members. We are always excited to see clean up jobs around the ranch; but if the clean-up job requires several truck loads or is a contract job, then the member/ contractor needs to make arrangements to get their own bin. You are also required to make sure that your trash is secure, bagged or covered to prevent roadside trash.

If you do not have a sticker or have already brought in a truck load for the week you may be turned away. If you have any questions or concerns regarding transfer station use please go to the association office and ask to speak to a board member.

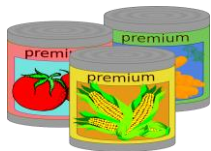
Keep your animals contained to your property!

One of the benefits to owning property in Rancho Tehama is being able to have animals that you may not be able to keep in town. However, one thing remains the same; **YOU MUST KEEP YOUR ANIMALS ON YOUR OWN PROPERTY.** Allowing your animals to roam is a hazard to both your animal, other animals and people. Your animal can be struck by a vehicle, which can cause harm to the animal, driver and vehicle. If your animal is off your property they can be picked up by animal control. If your animal becomes a threat to others or other people's animals your animal can be at risk of being shot.



Our Maintenance Crew is working hard, making improvements throughout the ranch. Please always use caution and drive slowly when you see the crew members working. We will report reckless drivers that put our employees and other member's lives at risk! Everyone's safety is of the utmost importance. Just like Cal-Trans says; "slow for the cone zone"!

Forms at the Office: Work Request Forms: if you notice an area that needs attention, such as pot holes or missing road signs. Complaint Forms: to alert the association of CCR violations. Information Request: If you would like copies of association documents. Payment Plan Forms: If you have fallen behind in your assessments and need to make payments to get caught up. Committee and Employment Applications: If you would like to volunteer for one of our committees or apply for employment with the association. Change of Address & Renter Registration: All members are responsible to make sure we have their current contact information. A change in address and adding renter information must be in writing. Please keep in mind that some items need to go through an approval process (payment plans/document request) and charges may apply (Document Request/ Culvert Installation). We also have several county forms for your convenience.
