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## 2015 Annual Election

The Extended Annual Member's Meeting/ Director Election was held on September 10<sup>th</sup> at 4pm. Even with mailing a second round of ballots we still failed to reach quorum. A total of 442 ballots were received and 546 are needed in order to count the votes. The election was extended and the board petitioned the court to allow us to count the ballots received as quorum. The court date for the judge to hear our petition is scheduled for November 9<sup>th</sup>. Be sure to keep an eye out for a mailing with more details.

You still have time to cast your ballot. Ballots will be accepted and counted toward quorum during this process. If enough ballots are received before the court hearing we can cancel the court date and count the ballots. A meeting is already scheduled for October 22<sup>nd</sup> at 4pm to count the votes, if we receive quorum before then. You can save the association time and money by simply returning your ballot. If you're not sure if you already voted you can check with the association office and receive a replacement a ballot if needed.

### Culverts

Installing a drainage ditch and culvert(s) may be recommended for some residents with drainage issues on their properties. The homeowner is responsible to pay for the cost of the culverts, but installation of culverts at driveways is done without additional cost. If you are interested in adding a culvert, you will need to fill out a work order with the Association. It is also important for members with culverts/ditches on their properties to do routine maintenance and cleaning to prevent flooding.

Please note the following limitations: No tires larger than 17", no truck or equipment tires; tires must be off the rim; no more than 40 tires per residence; only transport up to 9 tires at a time (DOT regulations) without an exemption.
