Board of Director Election

The Board of Director election was held on Thursday, September 22nd. We received 380 returned ballots, a quorum was not achieved and the ballots could not be counted. The election was extended to Saturday October 8th at 1pm in hopes that the judge will allow us to count the ballots as received. The hearing will be held September 26 at 1:30 p.m. in Department 1 of Tehama County Courthouse, 633 Washington St. Red Bluff, CA 96080. This is still an open election! If you haven't voted please vote ASAP! We plan to count the ballots on Oct. 8th if the judge grants us authority to do so.

Quorum Amendment Election Ended

Due to a lack of member participation (votes) the amendment election was canceled. Although this is a very important issue, after extending the election for four months, sending extra ballots and adding the raffle as an incentive to vote we only received 474 returned ballots. As previously mentioned we need 745 **yes** votes to even take this matter before a judge.

Memorial Plaques

There are memorial plaques in the Rec. Hall with name plates of members that resided in Rancho Tehama through the years and have passed away. The VFW Aux. worked many years to add names and keep the plaques updated. As more people moved to Rancho Tehama the task became larger and larger. The Rancho Tehama Association volunteered to take over the job but it seems to have fallen in the cracks. We are attempting to play catch up for 2014 to current. If you have a loved one that passed away during the past two years, who was a member of the association or a long time resident, that you would like to have added to the plaques please notify the association office. We need the full name, date of birth and the date they passed away. It is impossible to know of each members passing and of the families' wishes for the name plaque, therefore going forward we will only add name plates for those that request it and provide the necessary information.

Flu Shots will be available at the Rec. Hall on October 21st from 1pm-3pm. Tehama County Health Services are providing flu shots based on a sliding scale determined by household income, Medicare Part B is accepted.
