**NO CAMPING ALLOWED!!**

There is no camping allowed on any lot or common areas. Rancho Tehama CCR's Section 8 (b) states:

“No temporary house, tent, garage, or other outbuilding shall be placed or erected on any lot; provided, however, that the Committee may grant permission for any such temporary structure for storage of materials during construction. No such temporary structures as may be approved shall be used at any time as a dwelling place; provided further that, with approval of the Committee as to size, location and utility connections, house trailers may be used for residential purposes.”

In addition, all the Ponds and Parks are day use only. Park hours are Dawn to Dusk. This means you are only allowed on the premises during daylight hours, unless permission is granted for a special event. These common areas are adjoining to members properties. Please be respectful to the neighbors by keeping noise down to a reasonable level, always clean up after yourselves and keep dogs leashed at all times. Never trespass onto other neighboring properties; all properties whether or not they are developed are privately owned. Use of the playground equipment or BBQ's are at your own risk.
