1. Must have Visible **TRANSFER STATION STICKER** matching vehicle and property owner.
2. **No Profanity, threats of violence, or illegal dumping.** Violations will result in immediate loss of privilege, possible Littering fine of \$1,000.00, and notification of Authorities.
3. Only 1 pick-up load or equivalent per week per property.

ARE YOUR ADDRESS NUMBERS POSTED CORRECTLY?

During an emergency time is critical. It is very important that your property address numbers are posted correctly so that emergency responders can find you quickly. Tehama County Fire Department has set standards for posting address numbers. Address numbers need to be clearly posted by the entrance to the property drive way visible from both directions of traffic. Each number should be 4" high and 3/8" wide, reflective on contrasting background. Numbers are most easily seen on a post. A nearby tree is not as easy to spot, and can take medical personnel much longer to find you. Numbers should be visible from any direction traveled on the roadway. Never place items in front of your address numbers, such as decorations or flower arrangements. Never allowed the accumulation of shrubbery, or leaves to block the address.
